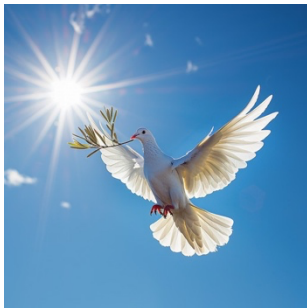

healing today. The entire service is displayed on the screen, as are the words to this morning's, hymns, songs and chants.

If you would like to receive the ministry of anointing and laying on of hands; please come forward as you would to receive Holy Communion. There's no need to say anything or reveal your medical history! Just trust in God and allow the Spirit to move within you. I'll place my hands gently on your head, and then anoint your forehead and the palms of your hands with the Oil of the Sick, that was consecrated by the Bishop at the Chrism Eucharist in Holy Week. If you would rather stay in your place, then that's absolutely fine as well!

EAST HOATHLY'S ORGAN: The PCC have voted to 'retire' the Bevington pipe organ until such time as funds are found to restore it. In the meantime, we have, after careful research, decided to commission a bespoke Wyvern Digital Organ for the much more realistic sum of £15k. This will give us an exceptional instrument, custom made and voiced for East Hoathly Church. We will need to do some fundraising to fully meet the cost, and any donations would be gratefully received! We are hoping that the new instrument will be in place for Remembrance Sunday, but if this is not possible, Wyvern Organs will loan us an instrument free of charge. I'm also planning a fund raising recital once the Organ is installed.
